Dr. Norman Shields is a clinical psychologist and applied researcher with an expertise in the evaluation and treatment of post-traumatic stress disorder in military veterans and their families.

In 2006, after a decade of service in provincial addiction and mental health services, Dr. Shields joined Veterans Affairs Canada to help develop a national network of operational stress injury clinics. He has collaborated on multiple research efforts to advance the dissemination of evidence-based treatments for PTSD, presented at national and international forums, and helped develop the first national OSI residential treatment program located at Ste. Anne's Hospital.

In 2016, he expanded his experience with the uniformed services and assumed a role in Canada's federal policing and occupational health.

Dr. Shields has been a member of the foundation's board of directors since 2011.
